



COURSE	Further Offshore Emergency Training (FOET)
AIM	The aim of the FOET is to provide the delegates with the opportunity to practice and demonstrate emergency response skills which are not possible to practice during drills, exercises and emergency training offshore.
TARGET AUDIENCE	This course is designed to meet the further offshore safety and emergency response training requirements for personnel working in the offshore oil and gas industry.

DELEGATES PRE-REQUISITES	The FOET is open to persons who have a valid (in-date) OPITO-approved BOSIET or TBOSIET, or FOET or TFOET certificate.
PHYSICAL AND STRESSFUL DEMANDS	Training activities contained within the OPITO standards may include physically demanding and potentially stressful elements. All personnel who participate must be physically and mentally capable of participating fully. The Centre shall keep a record of the delegate's/candidate's declaration of fitness in accordance with their document control policy or procedures.
